Statement of intent

Organisation

The overall responsibility for this policy rests with the POSHE top management, which has delegated authority to the Director for the purpose of putting it into practice.

All POSHE employees are responsible for their own and others' health and safety.

There is a particular responsibility for administration staff to supervise students and clients who come for inquiry, registration, or any other such purpose. The admin staff will have duty to ensure their health and safety, for example, by leading a safe building evacuation in the event of a fire or any other such emergency raised in the premises.

Covid 19 Measures
